Notice of amended Travel advisory as at 13th May 2021

The Cook Islands current Section 9A Notice for Refusal of Entry under the Entry, Residence and Departure Act 1971-72, signed into effect from 12 May 2020 and still active, is as follows;

All persons are denied entry into the Cook Islands unless there is an exemption provided (in writing) by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration.

Effective from 11.59pm Sunday 16th May 2021 (CKT), the following persons are exempted for entry into the Cook Islands, provided they meet the entry criteria specified below:

i. Any person who has been resident in New Zealand or the Cook Islands for 14 full days prior to entry into the Cook Islands

Entry Criteria

- ii. Completes the pre departure online Contact Information for travel to the Cook Islands form administered by Te Marae Ora, Cook Islands Ministry of Health; and
- iii. Meets Cook Islands Immigration entry requirements
