Notice of Travel Advisory updated at 4 November 2021

The Cook Islands current Section 9A Notice for Refusal of Entry under the Entry, Residence and Departure Act 1971-72, signed into effect from 12 May 2020 and still active, is as follows;

All persons are denied entry into the Cook Islands unless there is an exemption provided (in writing) by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration.

Effective from **11.59pm Thursday, 4th November 2021 (CKT)**, there will be no exemptions provided for entry into the Cook Islands up to **11.59pm, 12th January 2022 (CKT)**.

All requests for entry into the Cook Islands must be sought from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration (Te Kauono Tutara e te Mana Tiaki) on email: immigration2@cookislands.gov.ck
