Community Action

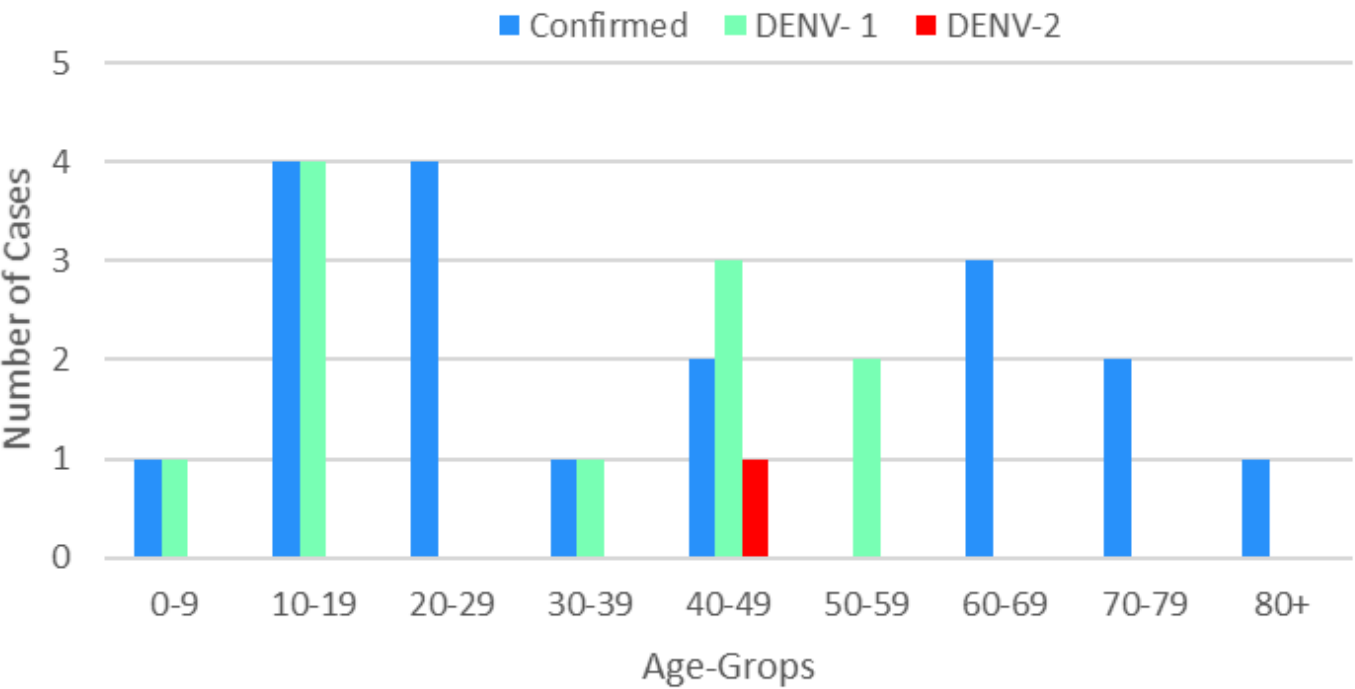
- Friday 23rd May 2025 a Mass cleaning took place in the 10 Puna led by TMO and supported by Puna leads also joining in were Private sector employees.

Border Control (Domestic flights)

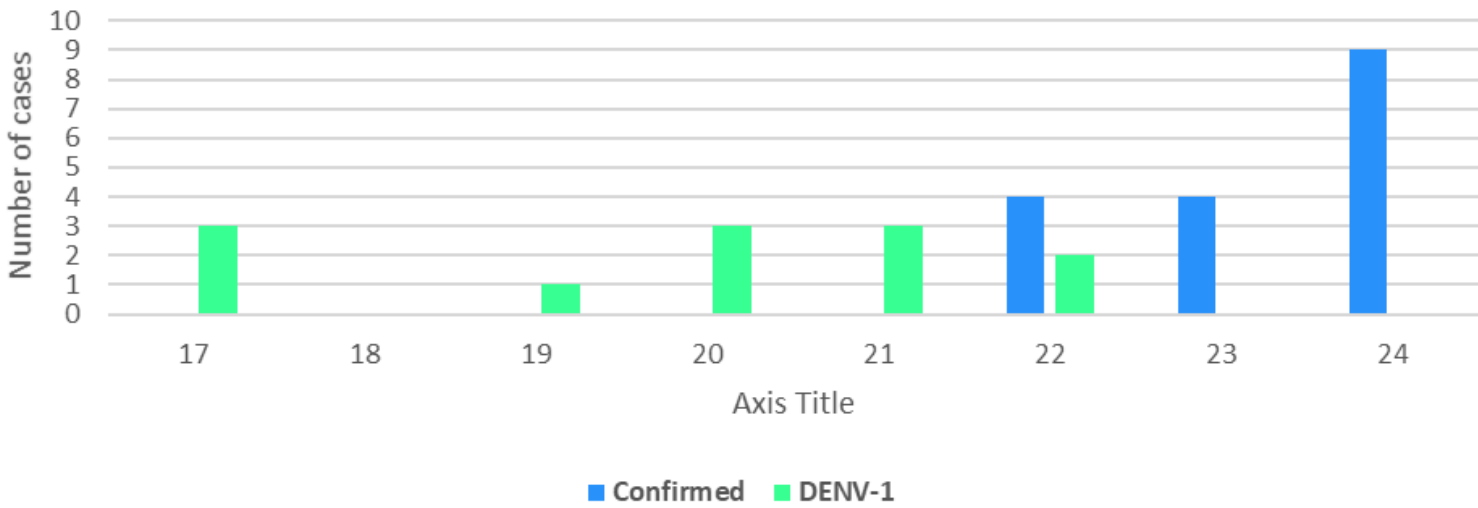
- Monitoring, screening of travellers to the Outer Islands.

Please note no Home and Peri-Focal spraying has taken place to date.

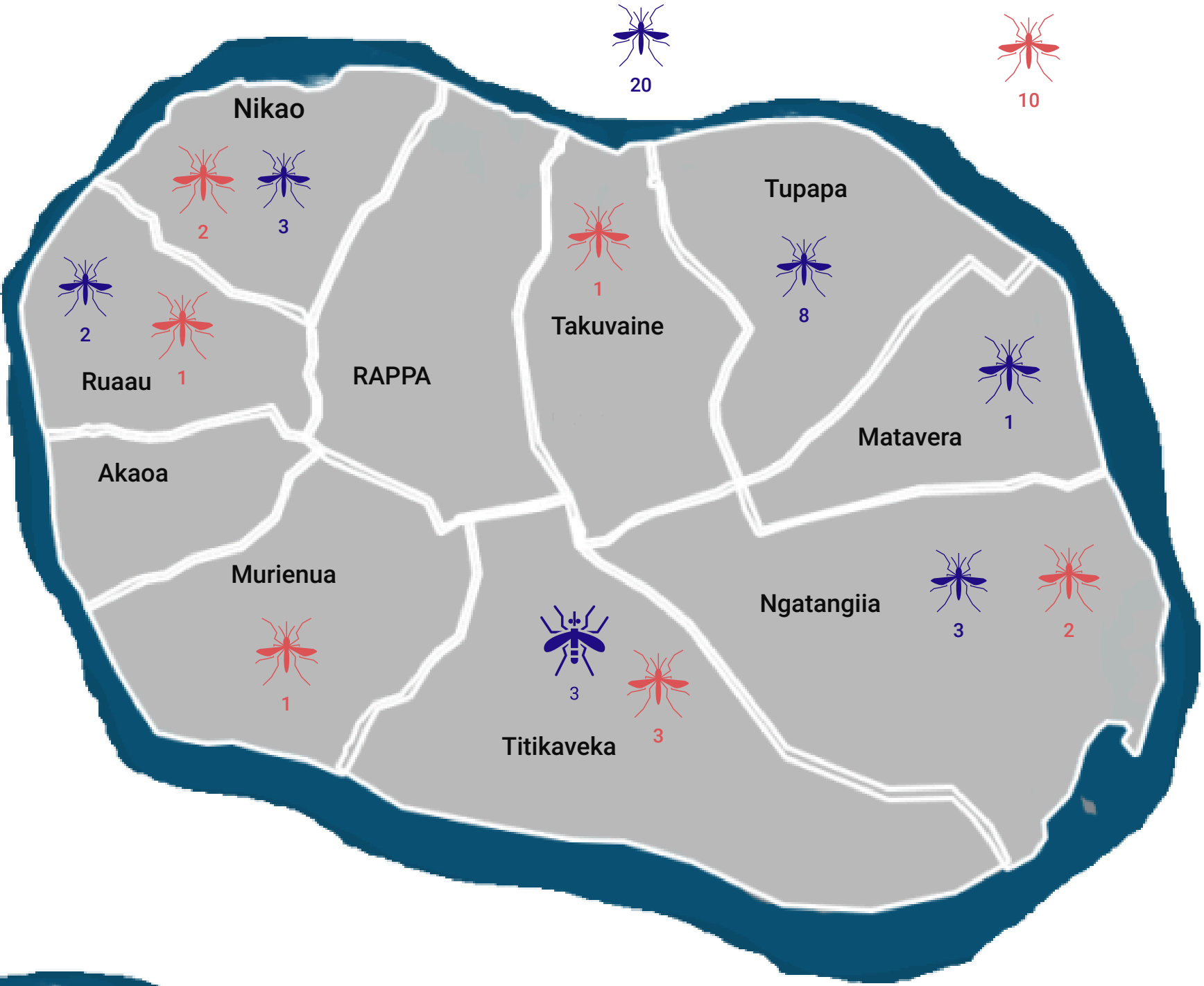
