Community Action

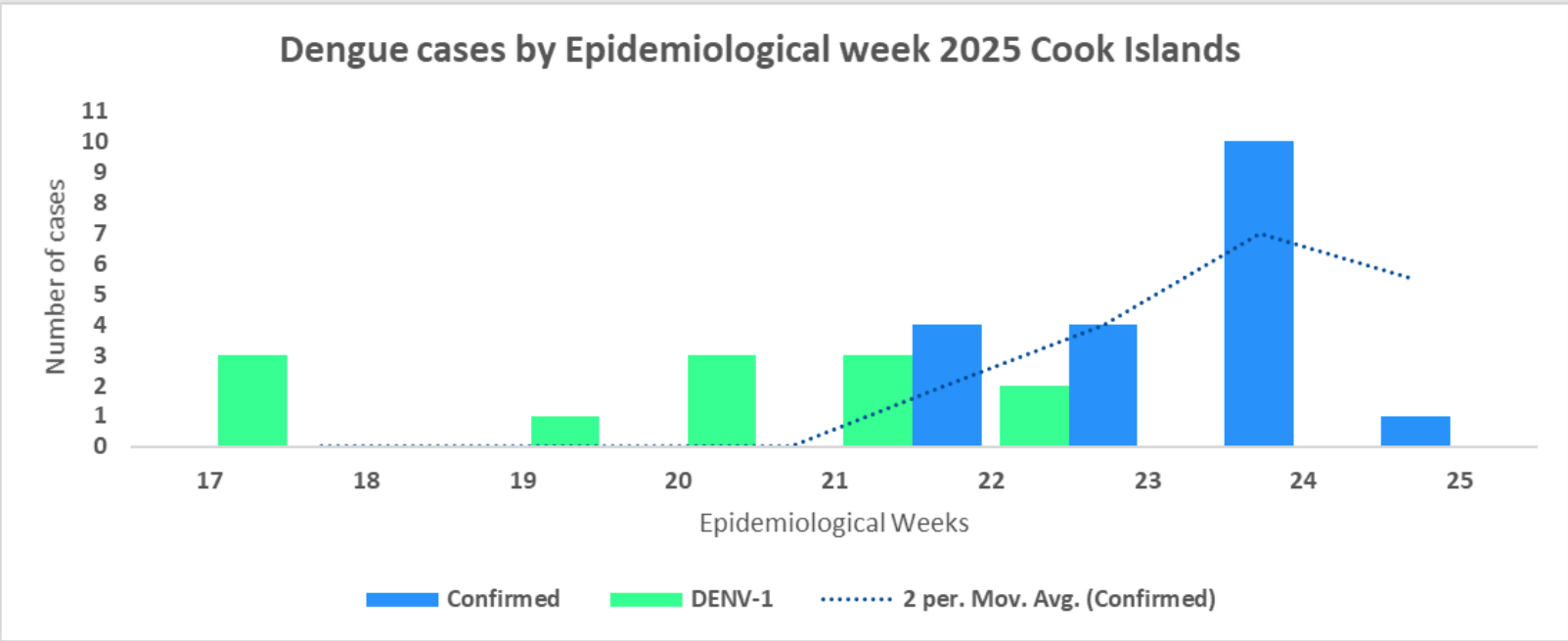
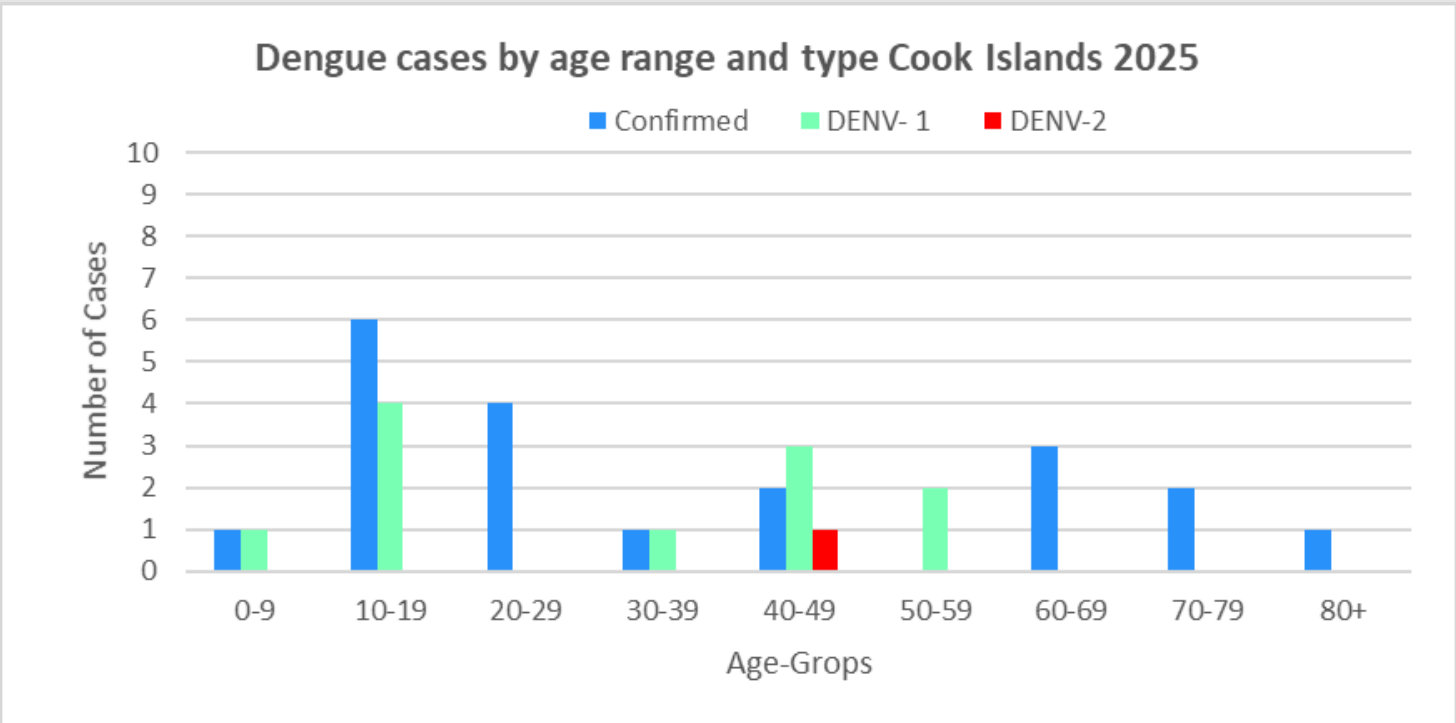
- Friday 23rd May 2025 a Mass cleaning took place in the 10 Puna led by TMO and supported by Puna leads also joining in were Private sector employees.

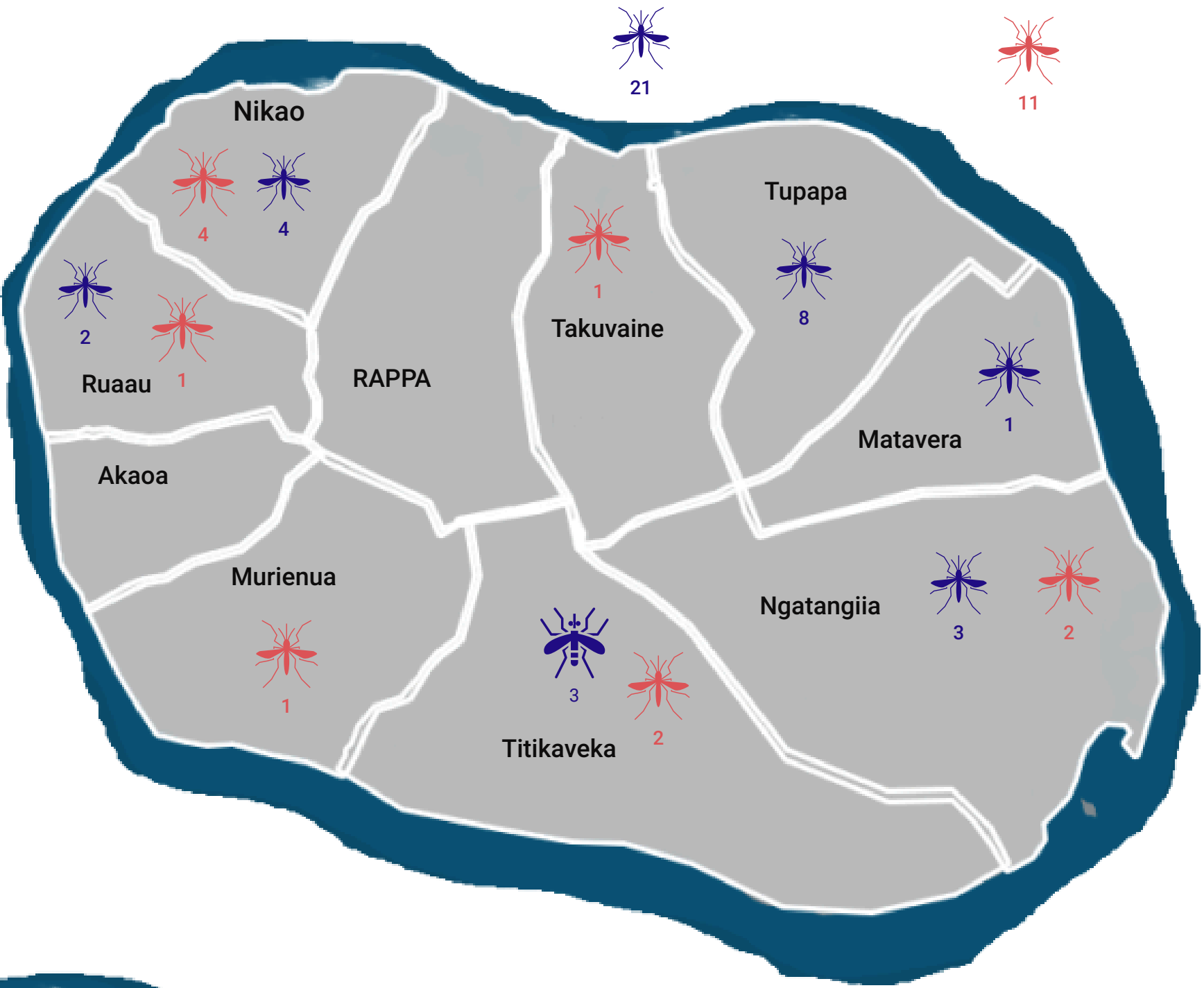
