Vector Control Programme

- Rarotonga: Peri-focal and block spraying targeting hot spots
- Risk assessments, and clean up: all islands.




Key Messages

- Remove mosquito breeding and resting sites

- Peri-Focal spraying continues.

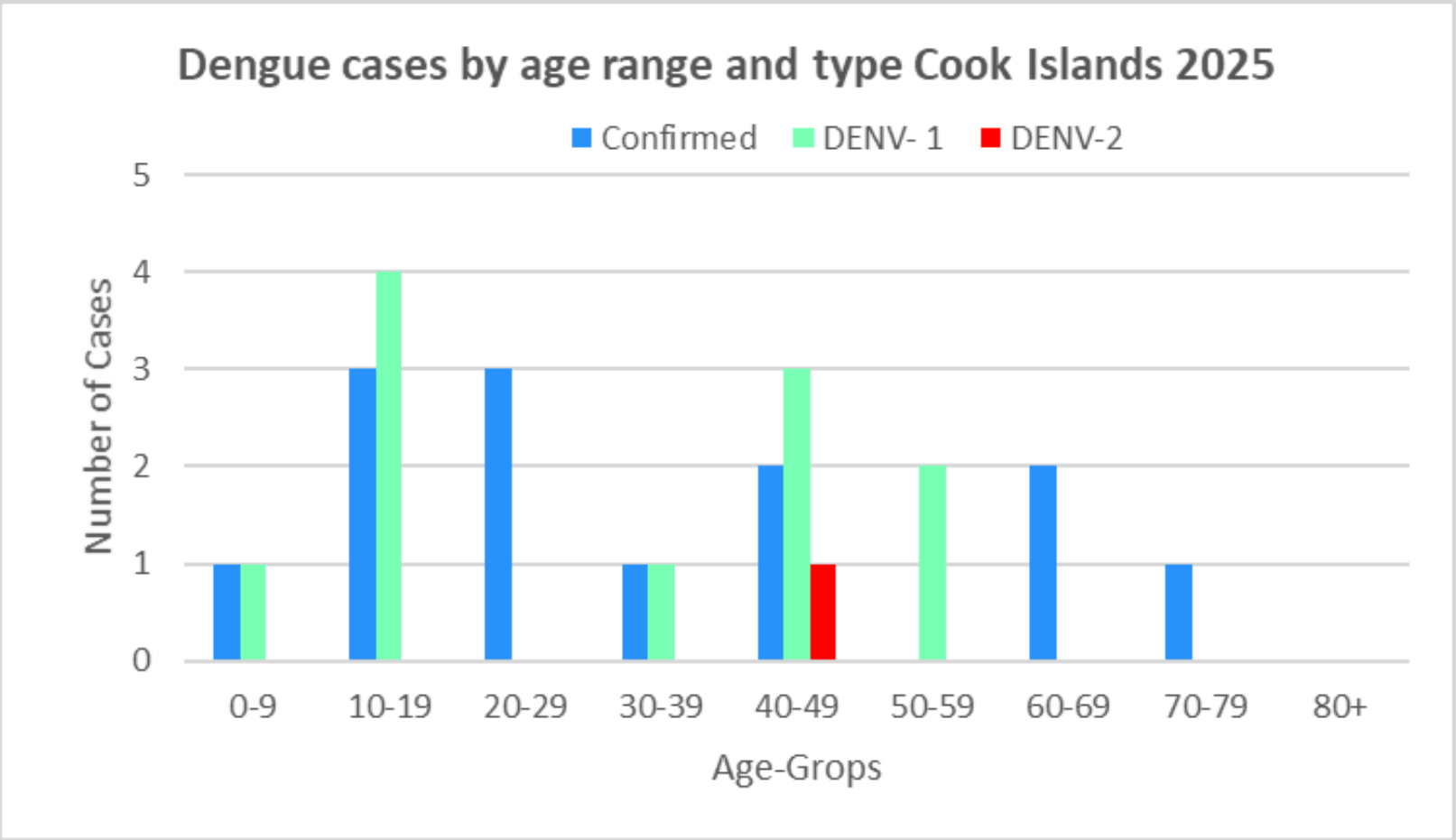
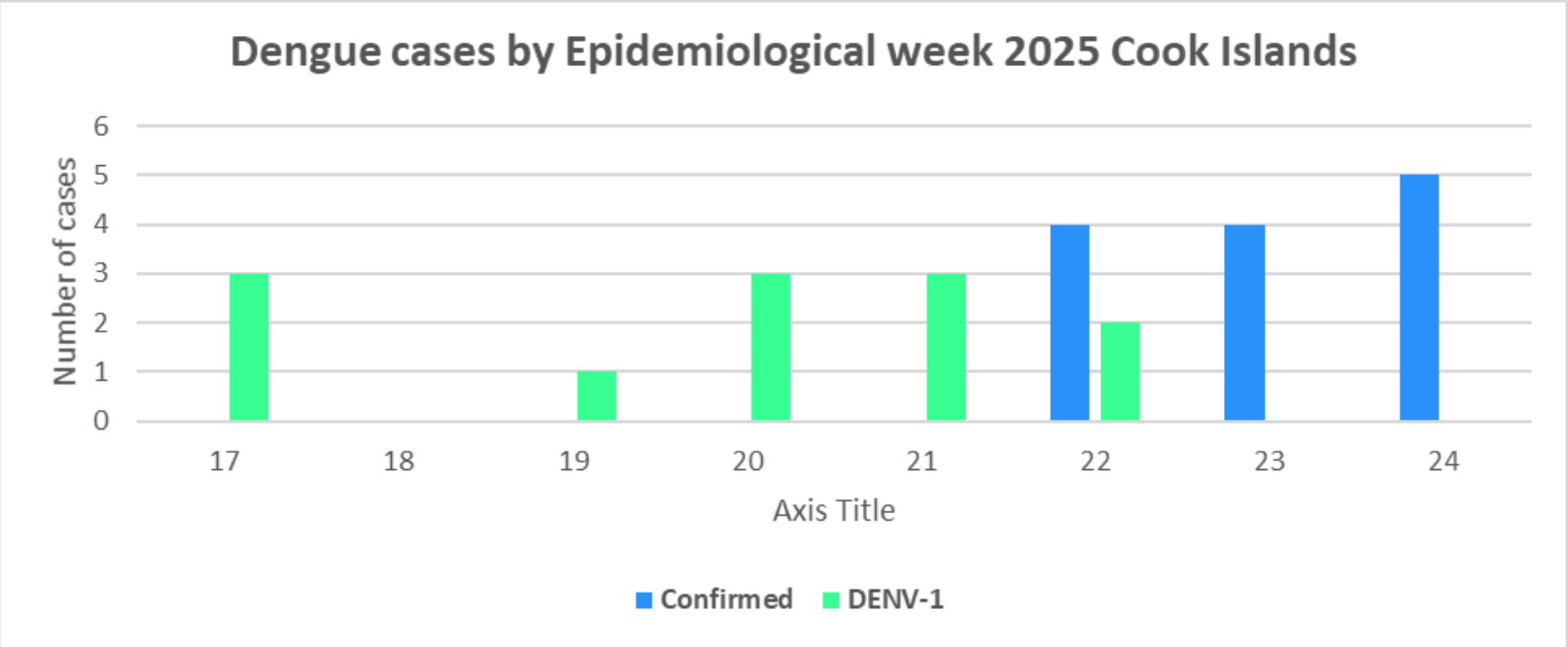

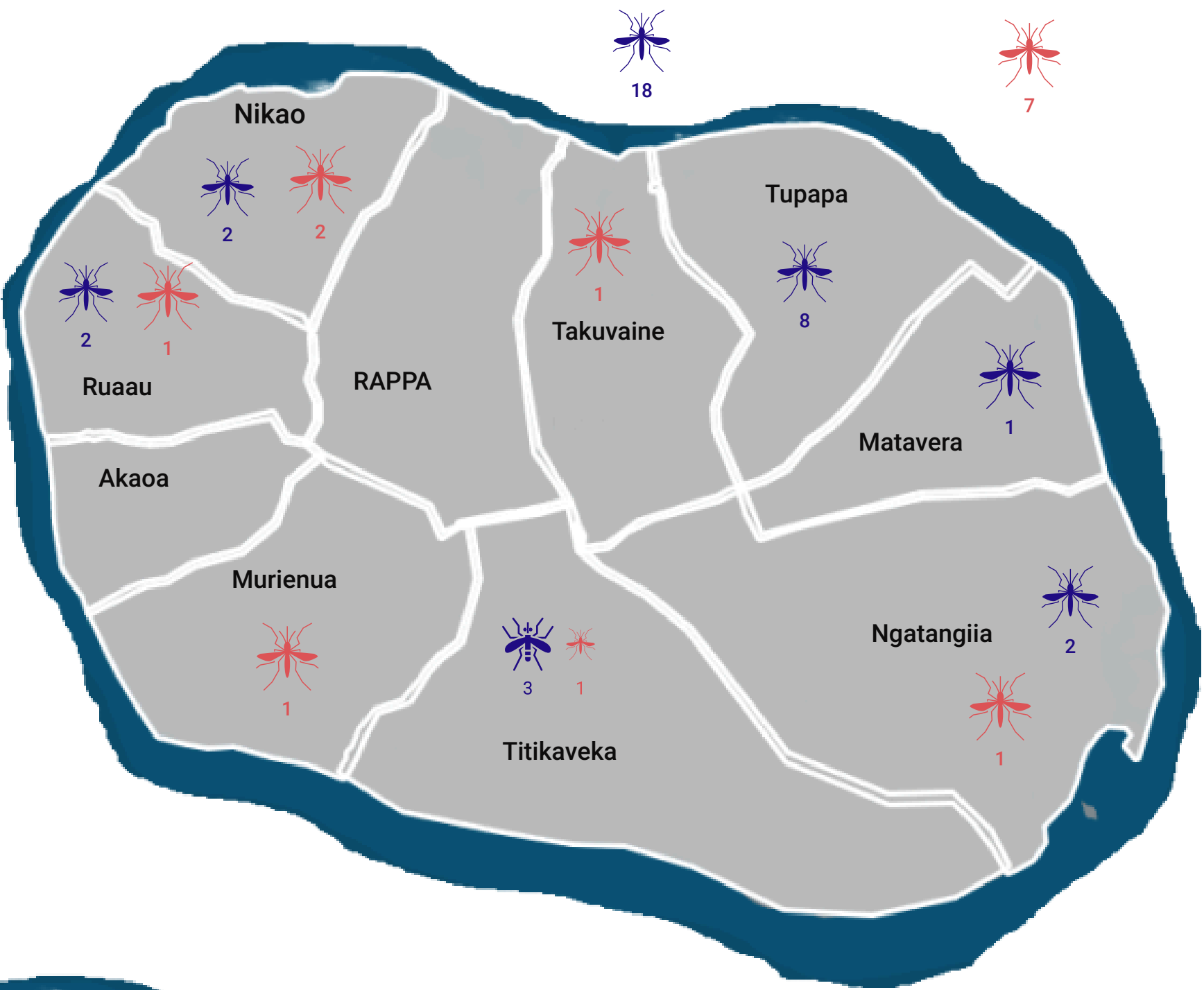
