- Rarotonga: Peri-focal and block spraying targeting hot spots
- Risk assessments, and clean up: all islands.



### Key Messages

- Remove mosquito breeding and resting sites



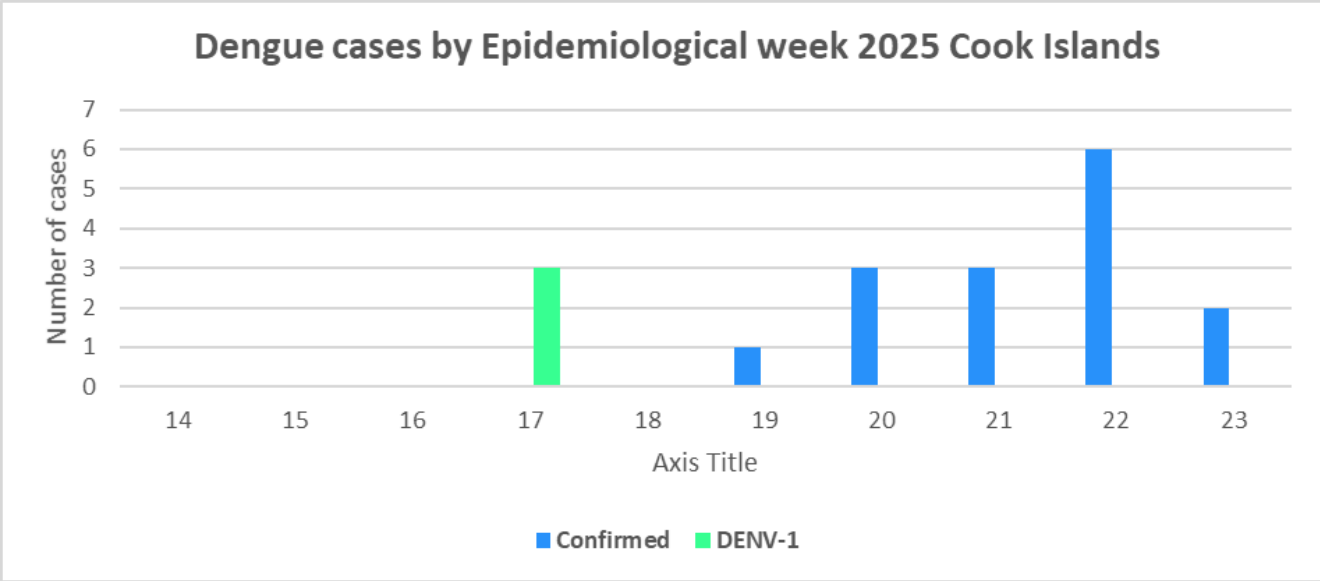
### Community Action

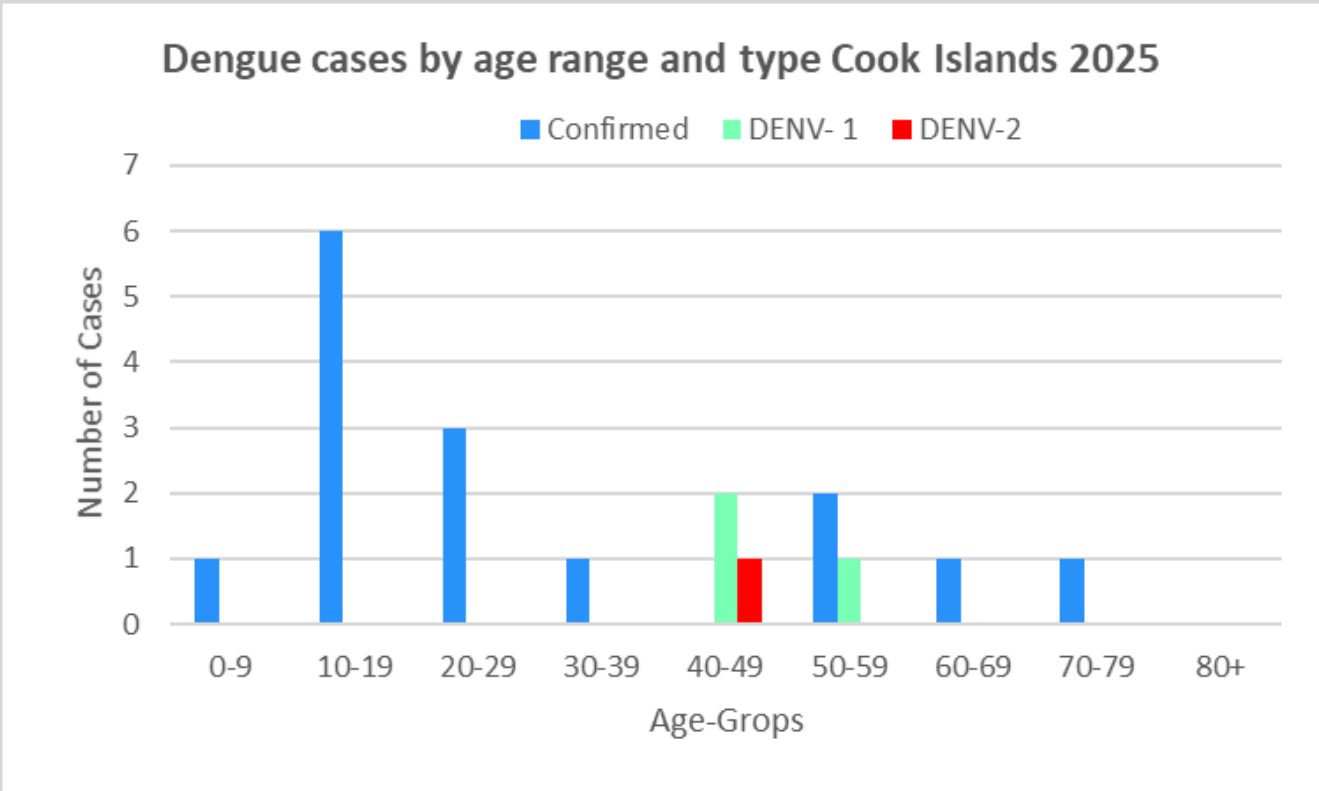
