- Remove mosquito breeding and resting sites



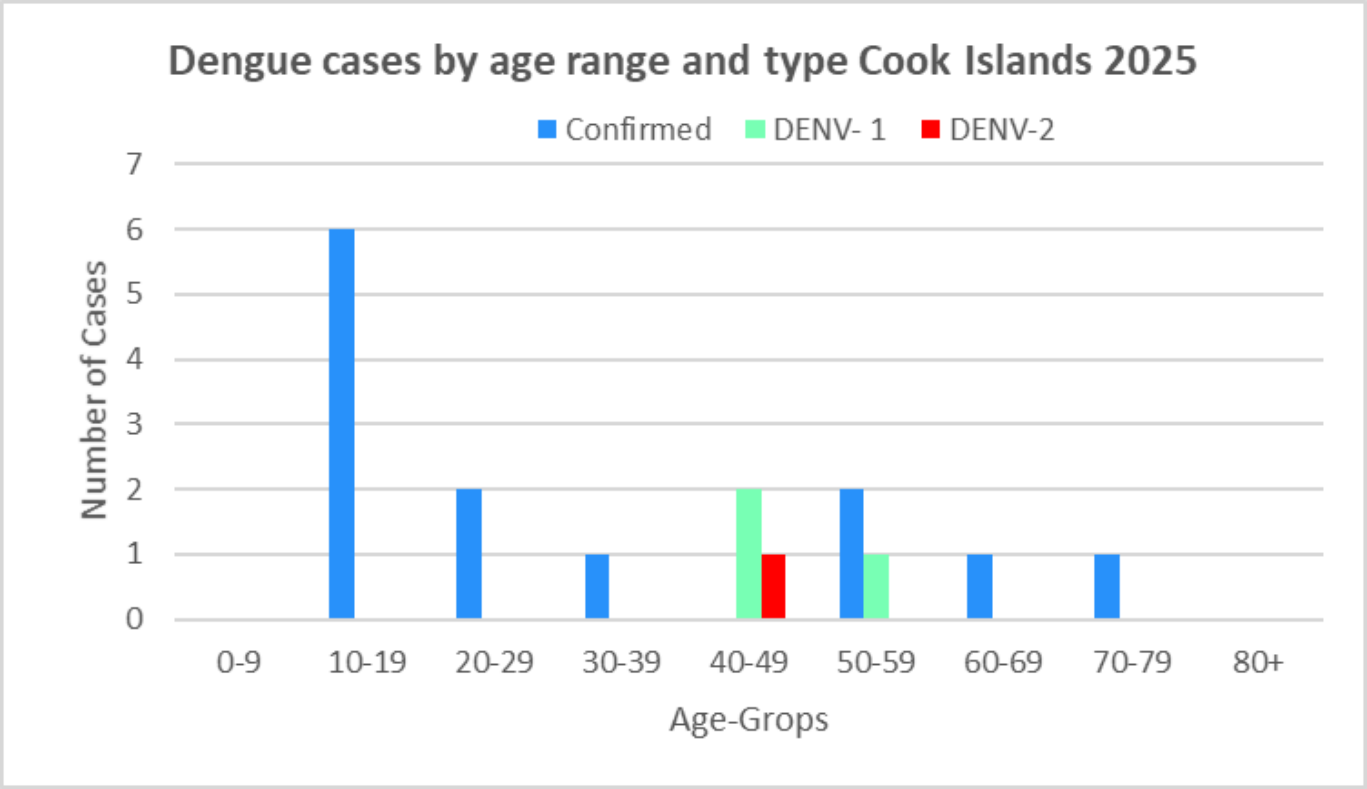
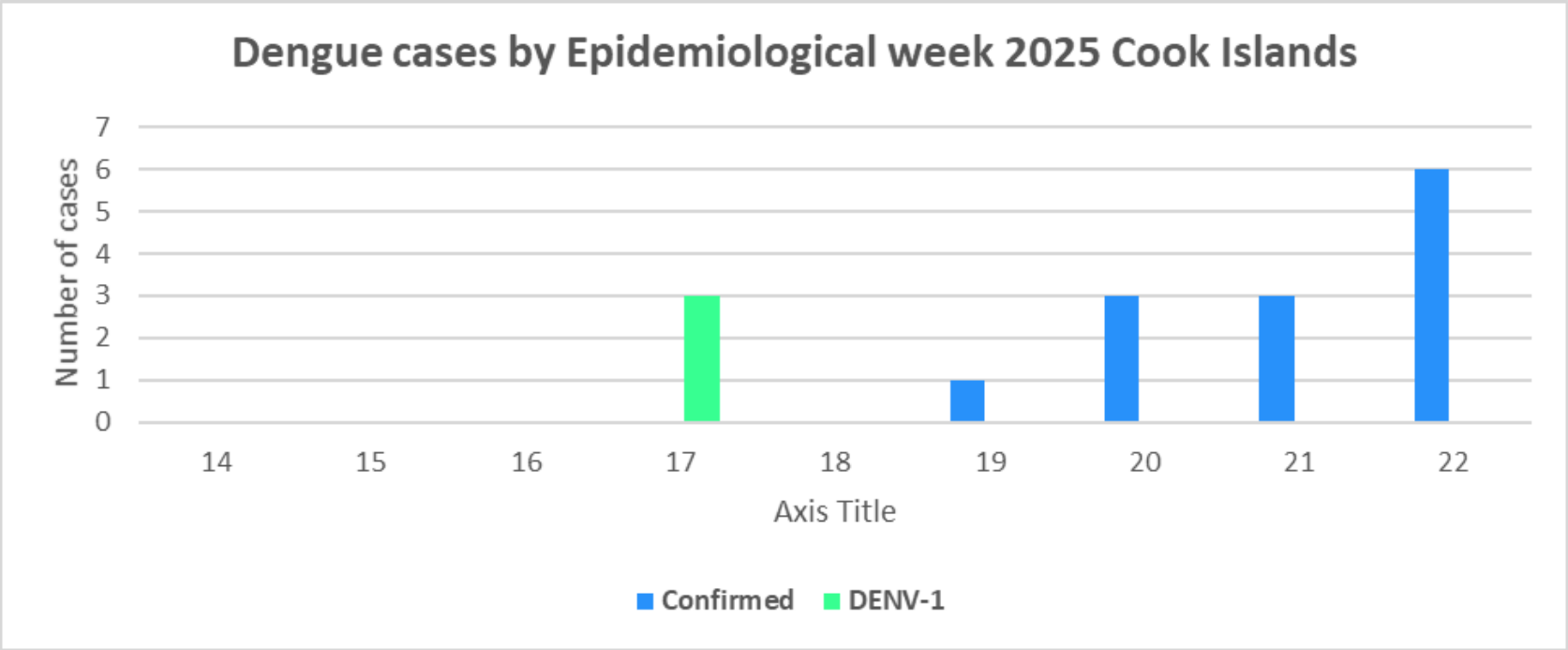
Community Action

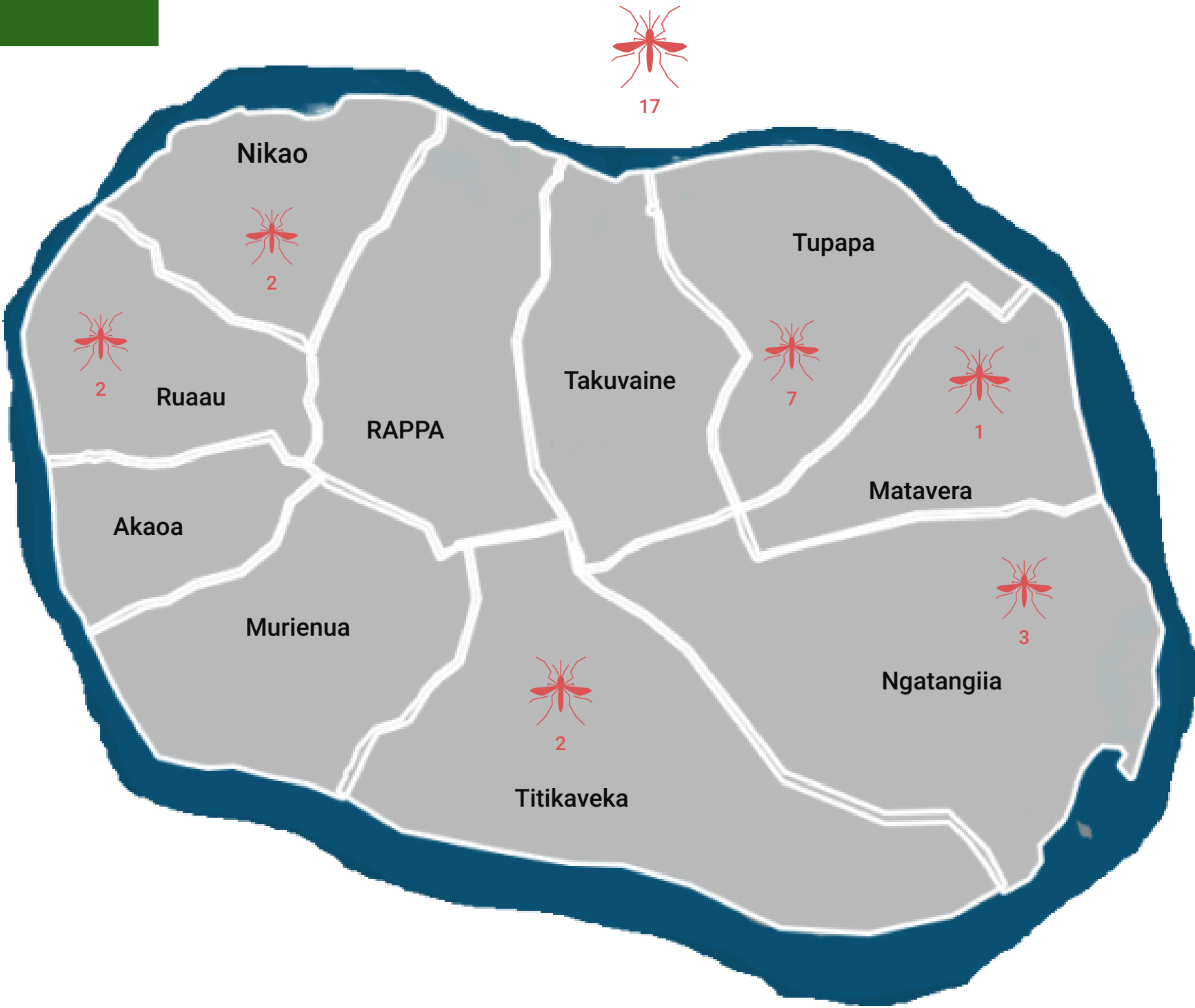
