Public Health Response Summary

Vector Control Programme

- Rarotonga: Peri-focal and block spraying targeting hot spots
- Risk assessments, and clean up: all islands.

Key Messages

- Destroy all mosquito breeding and resting sites
- Seek medical attention if unwell

Community Action

- Working with Puna for Mass Spraying Campaign (in progress)

Border Control (Domestic flights)

- Screening is adhoc and if required

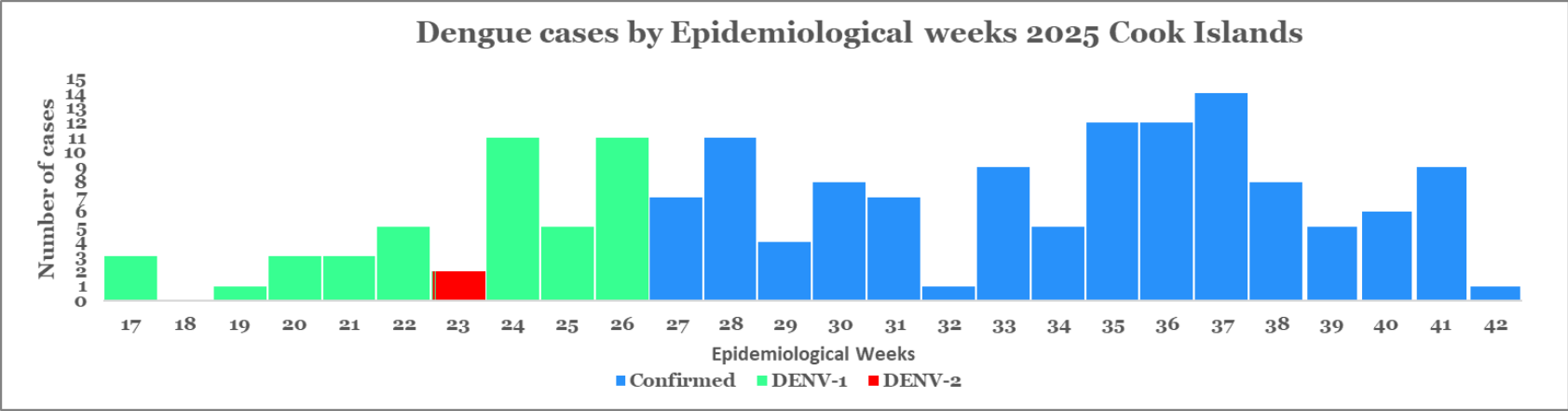

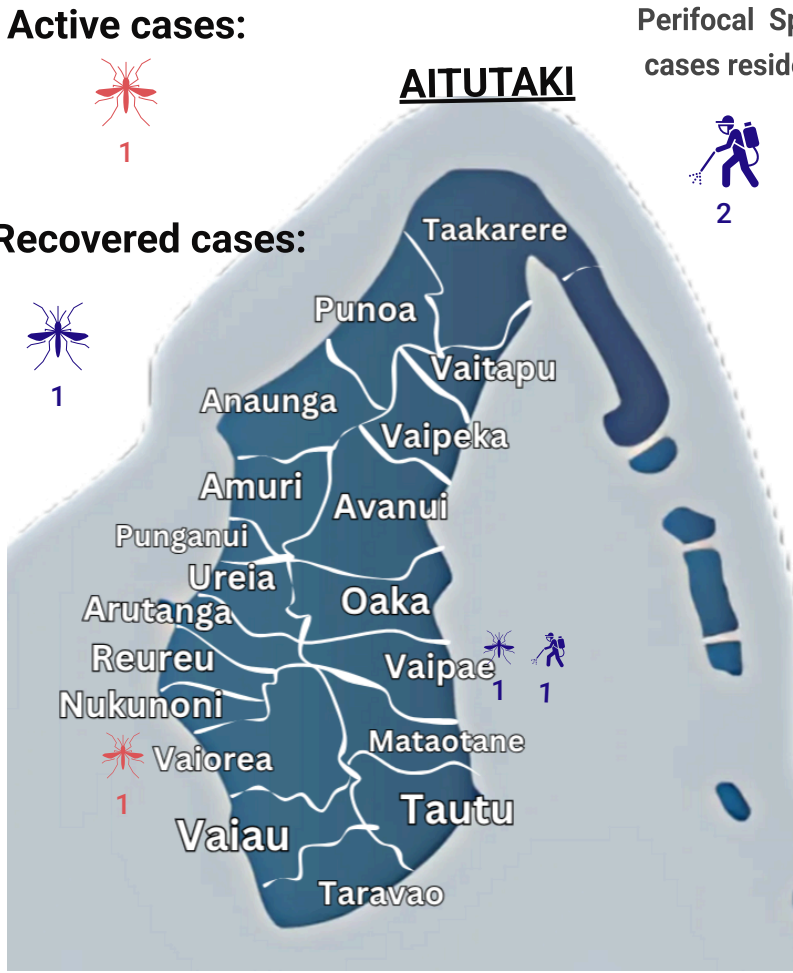

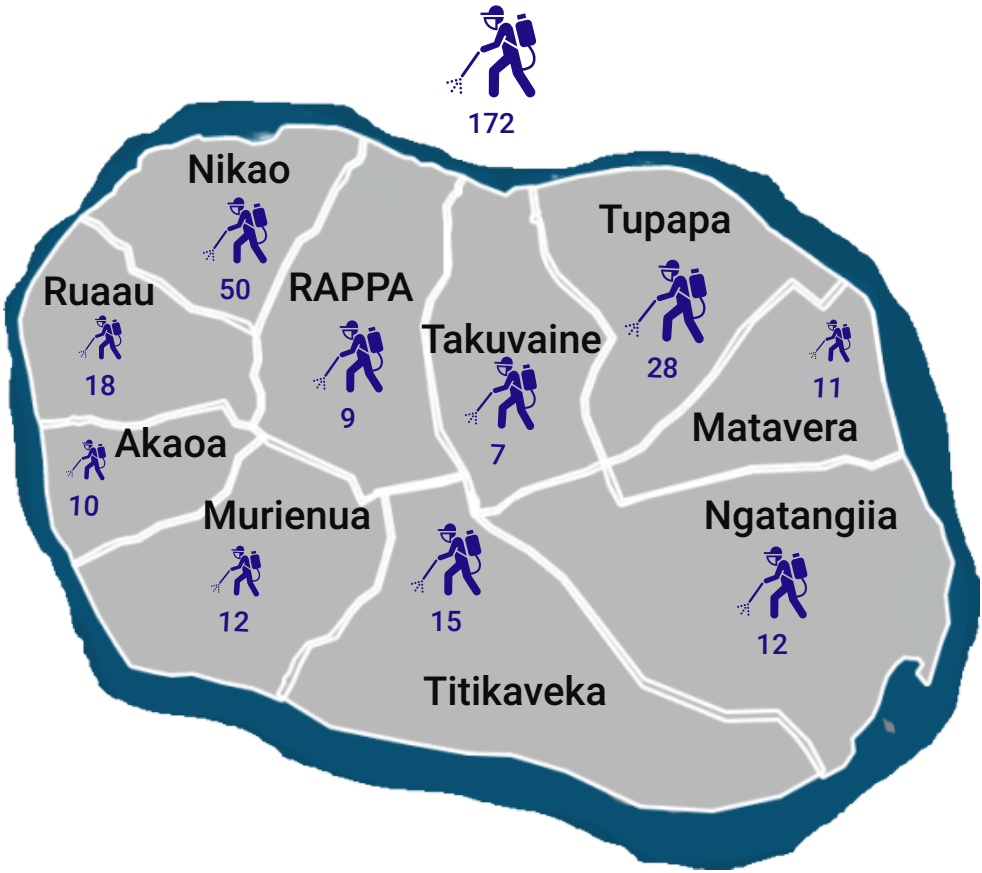


NOTES:
