- 3.30AM to 7am

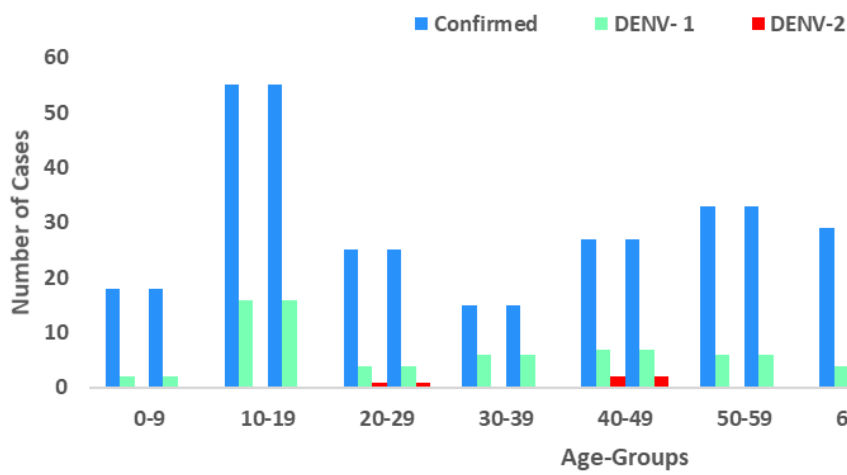

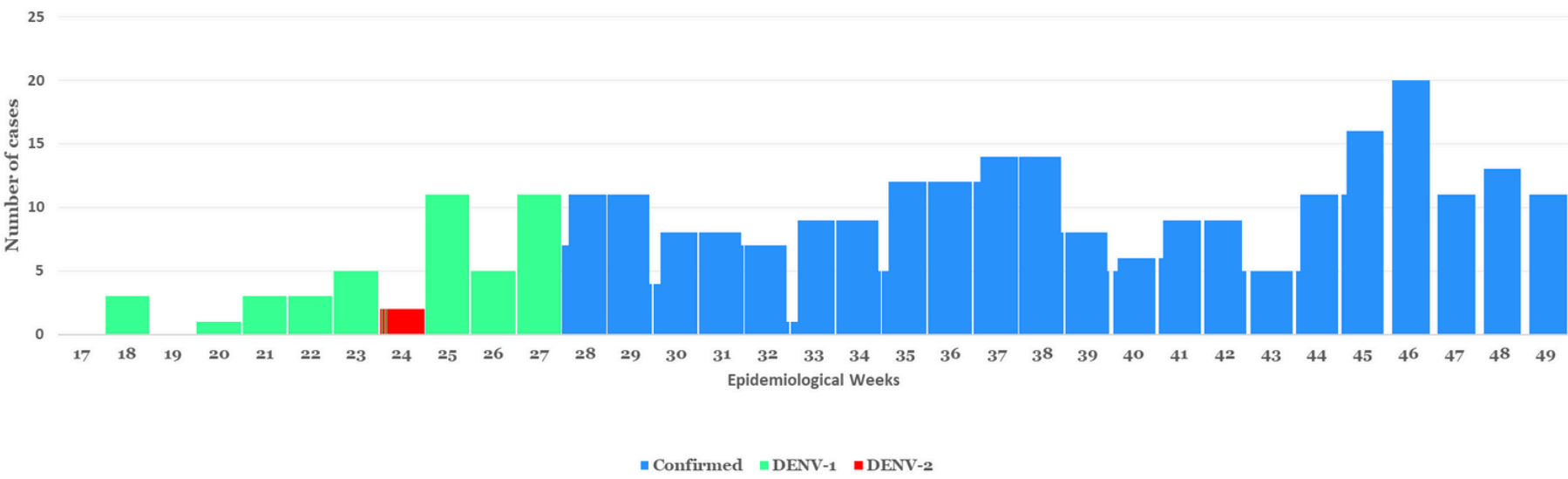

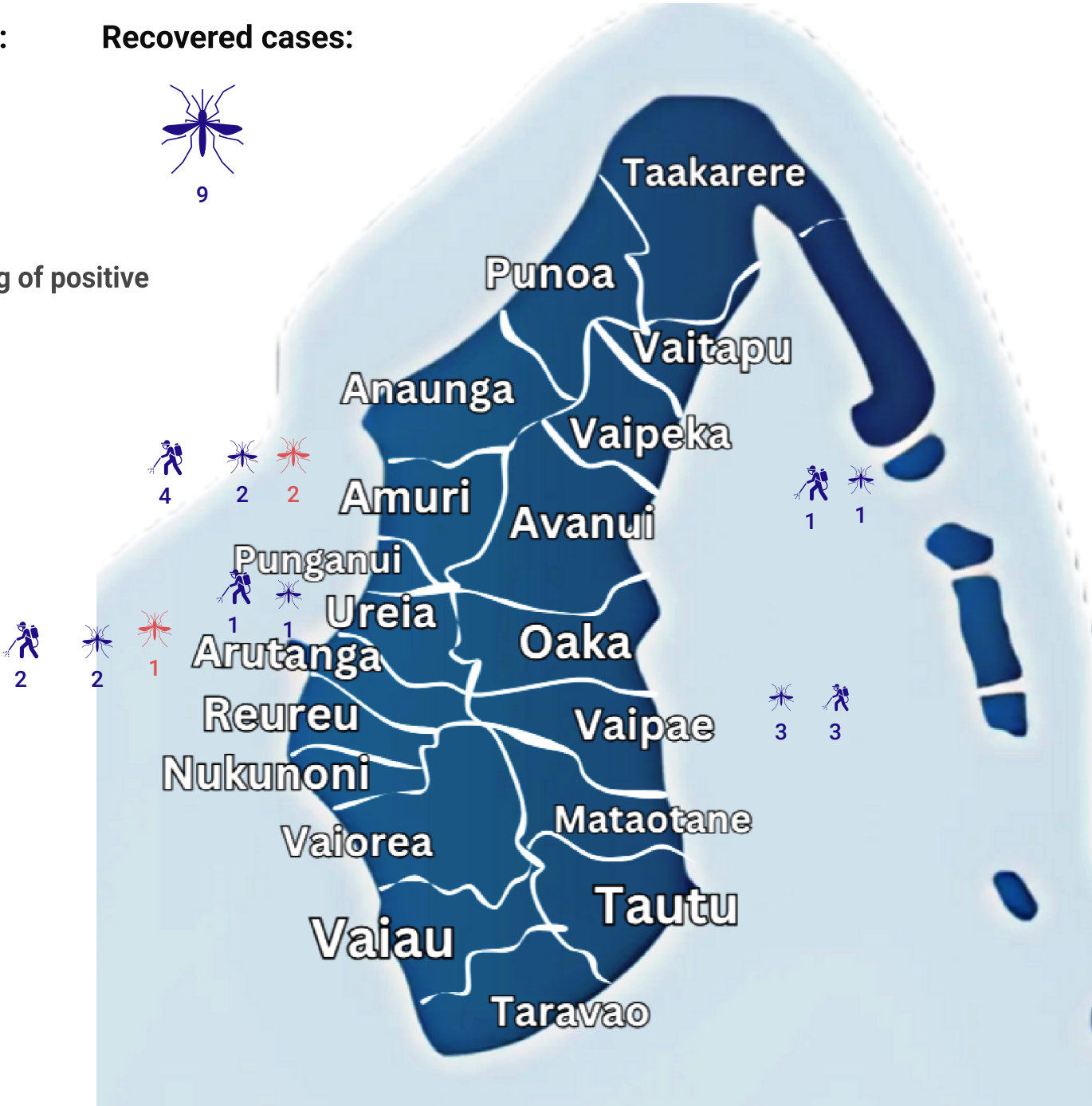
