Community Action

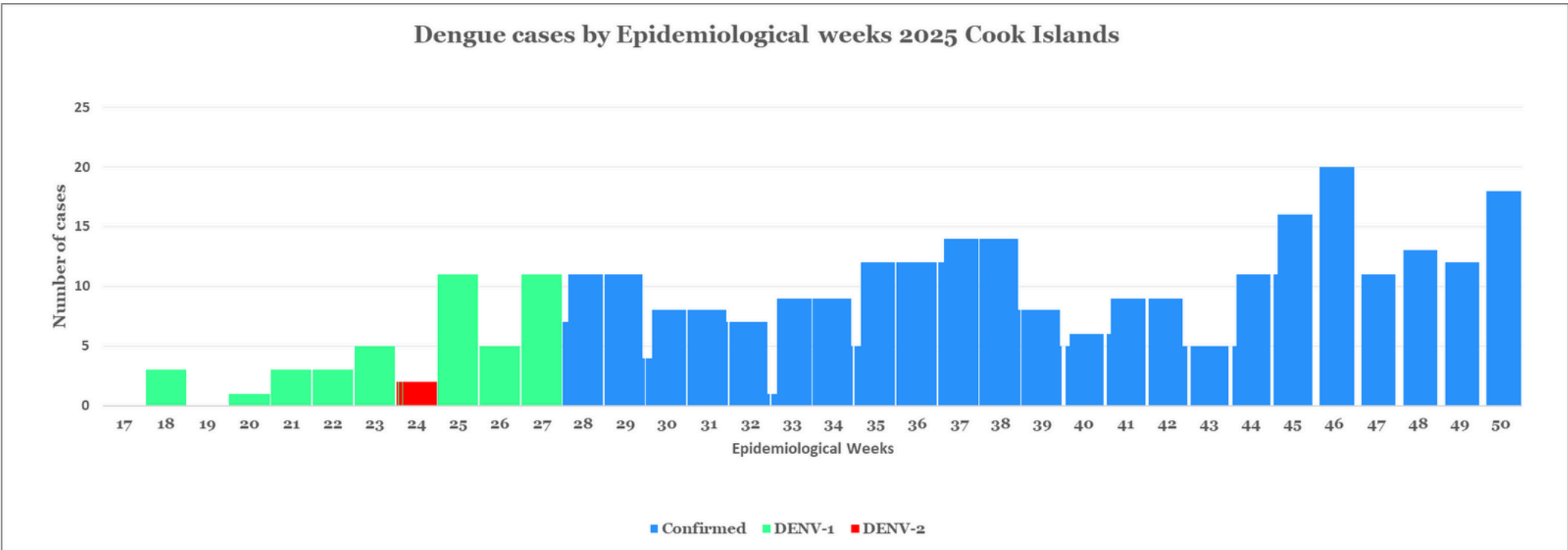
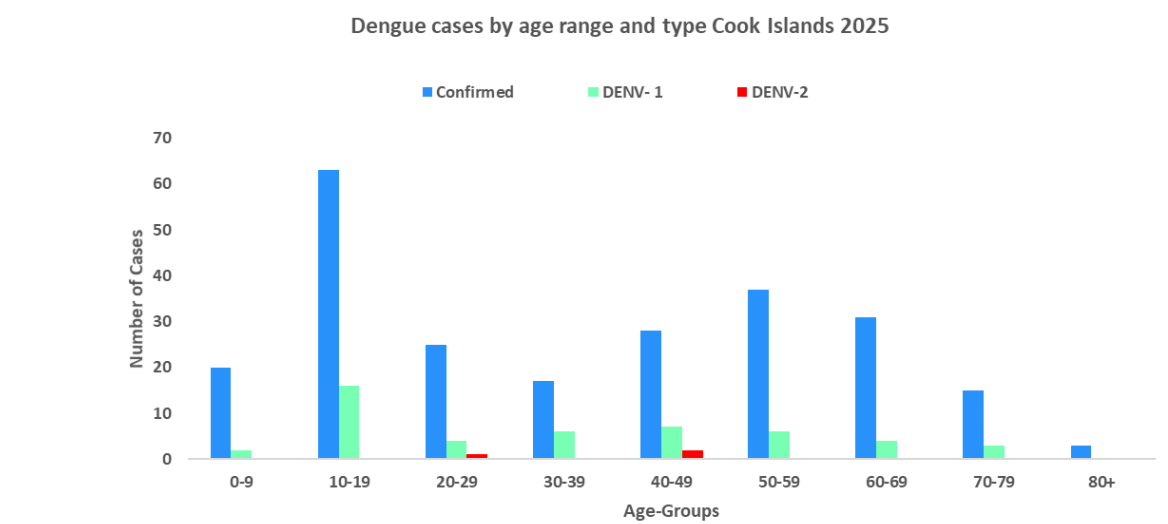
- Working with each Puna and Health Protection Unit with Mass cleaning.

- Screening is adhoc and if required

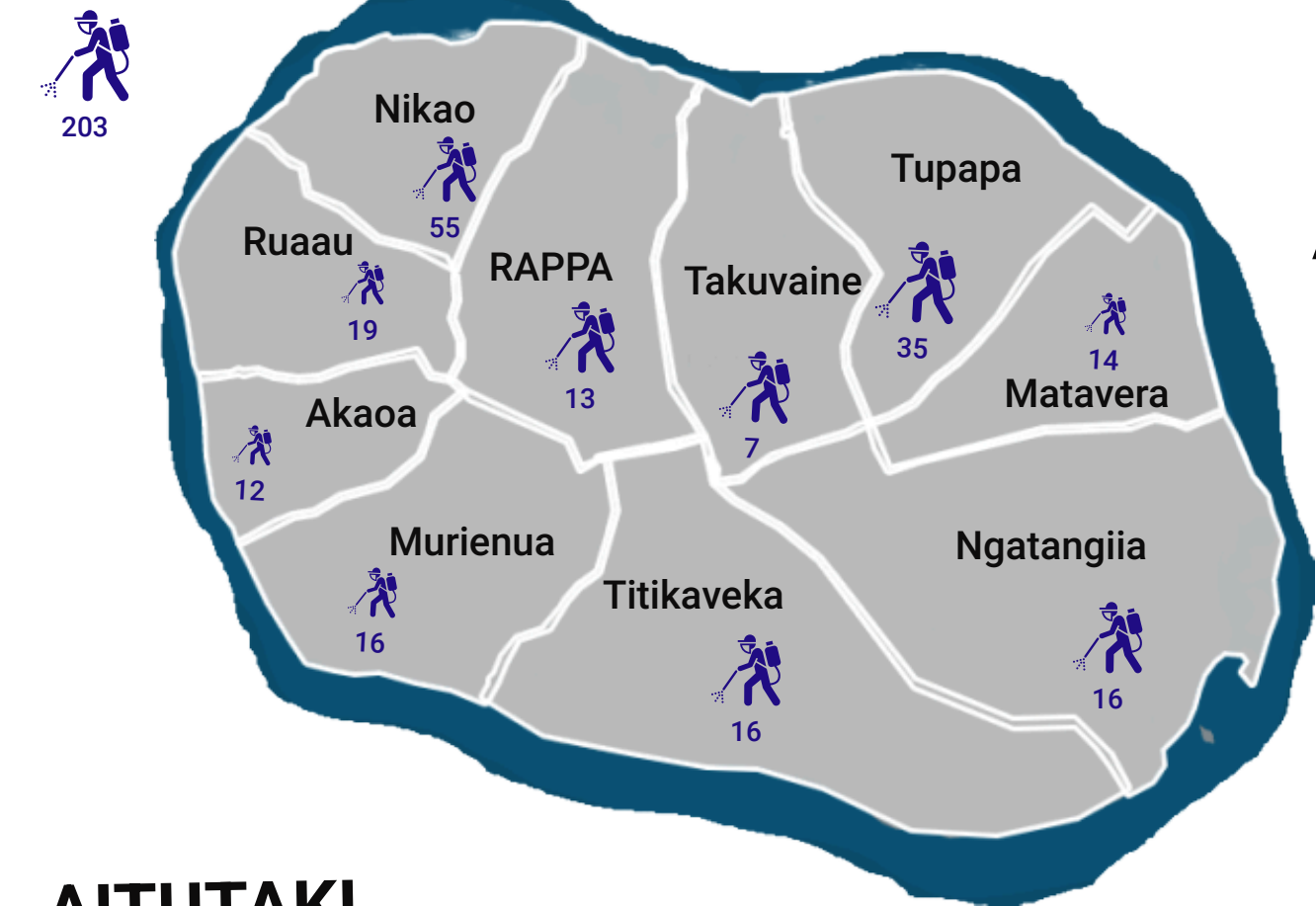

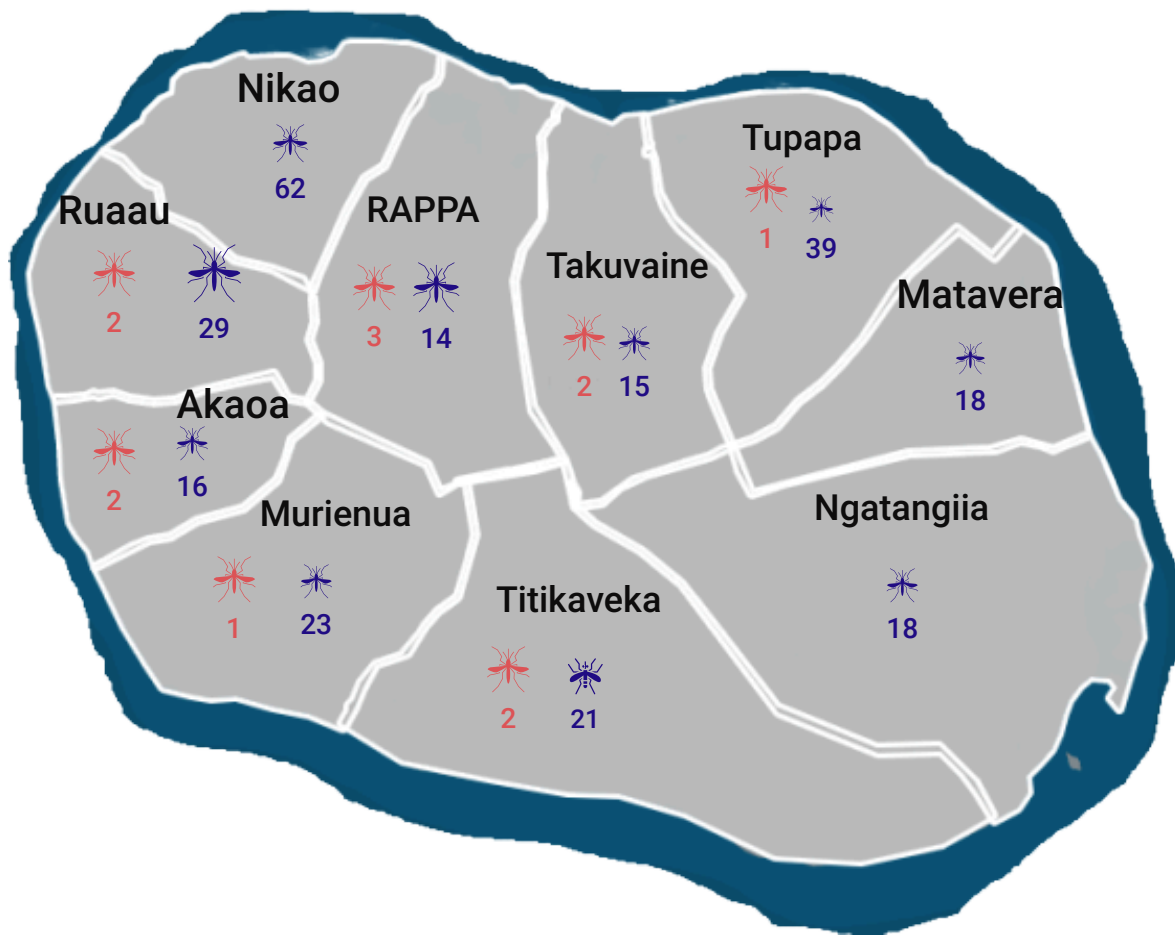

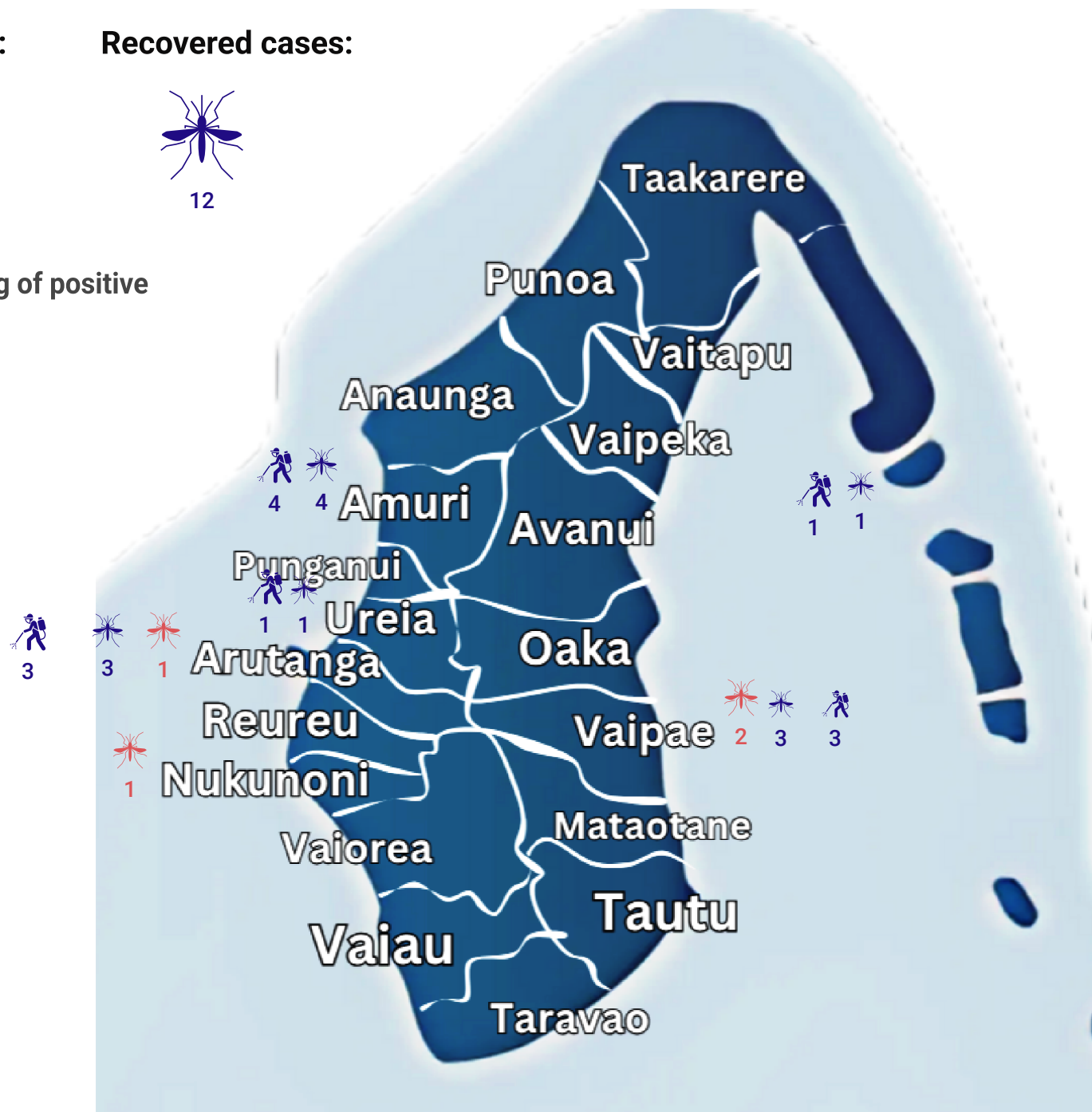
