Community Action

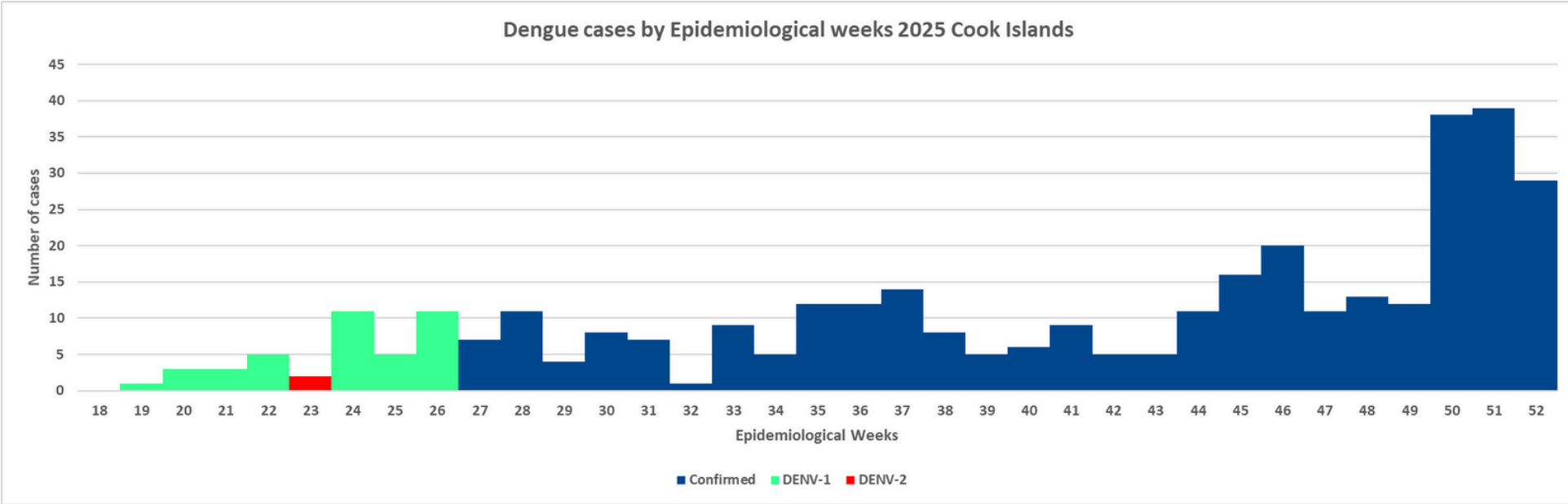
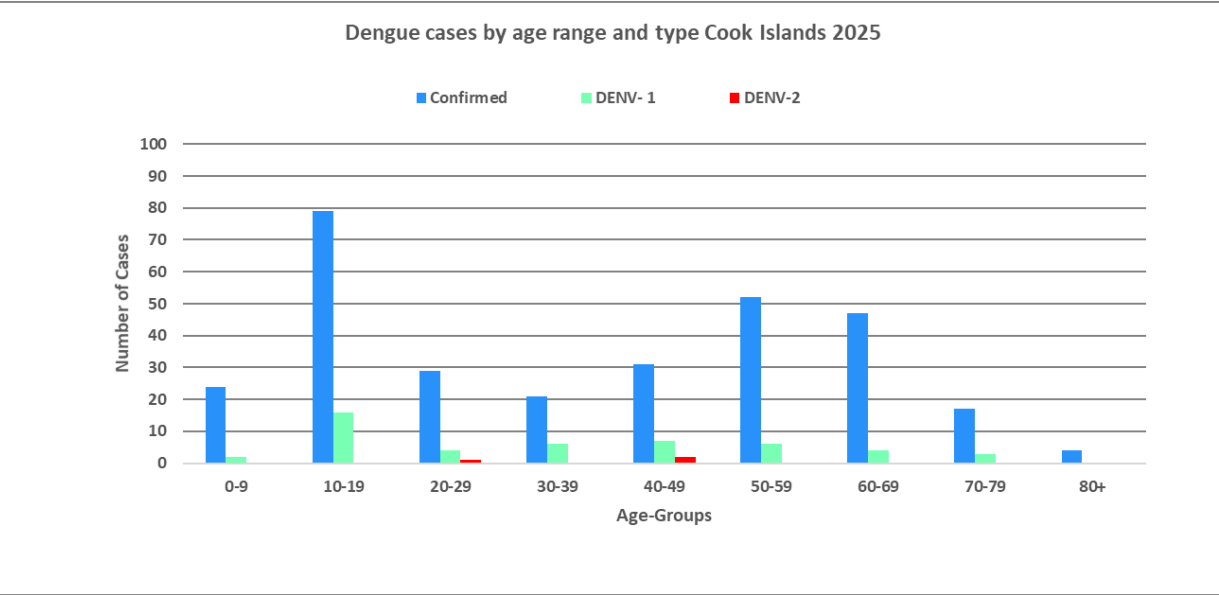
- Community Awareness - emptying water containers, use of repellent

- Border measures will be implemented as required

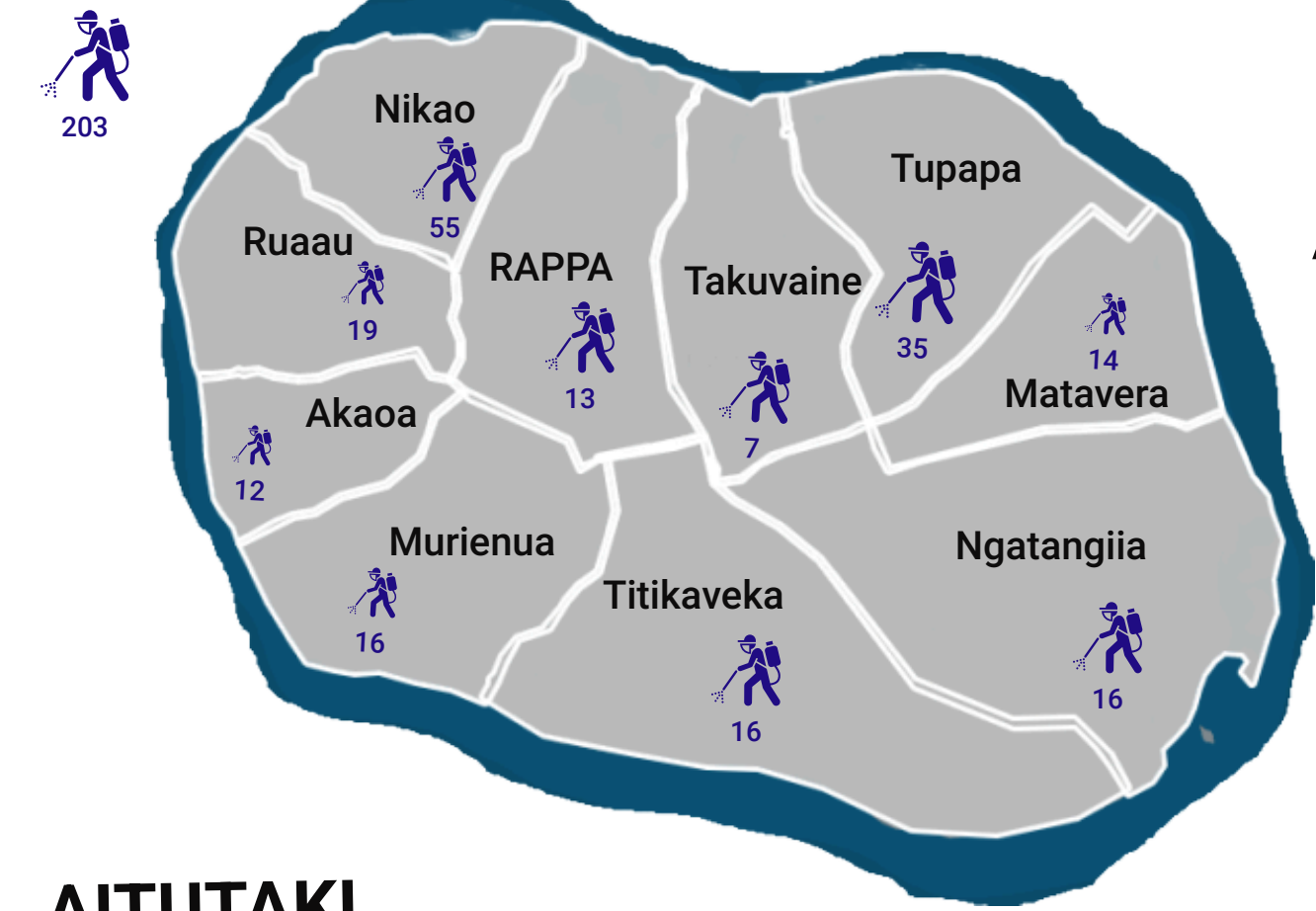

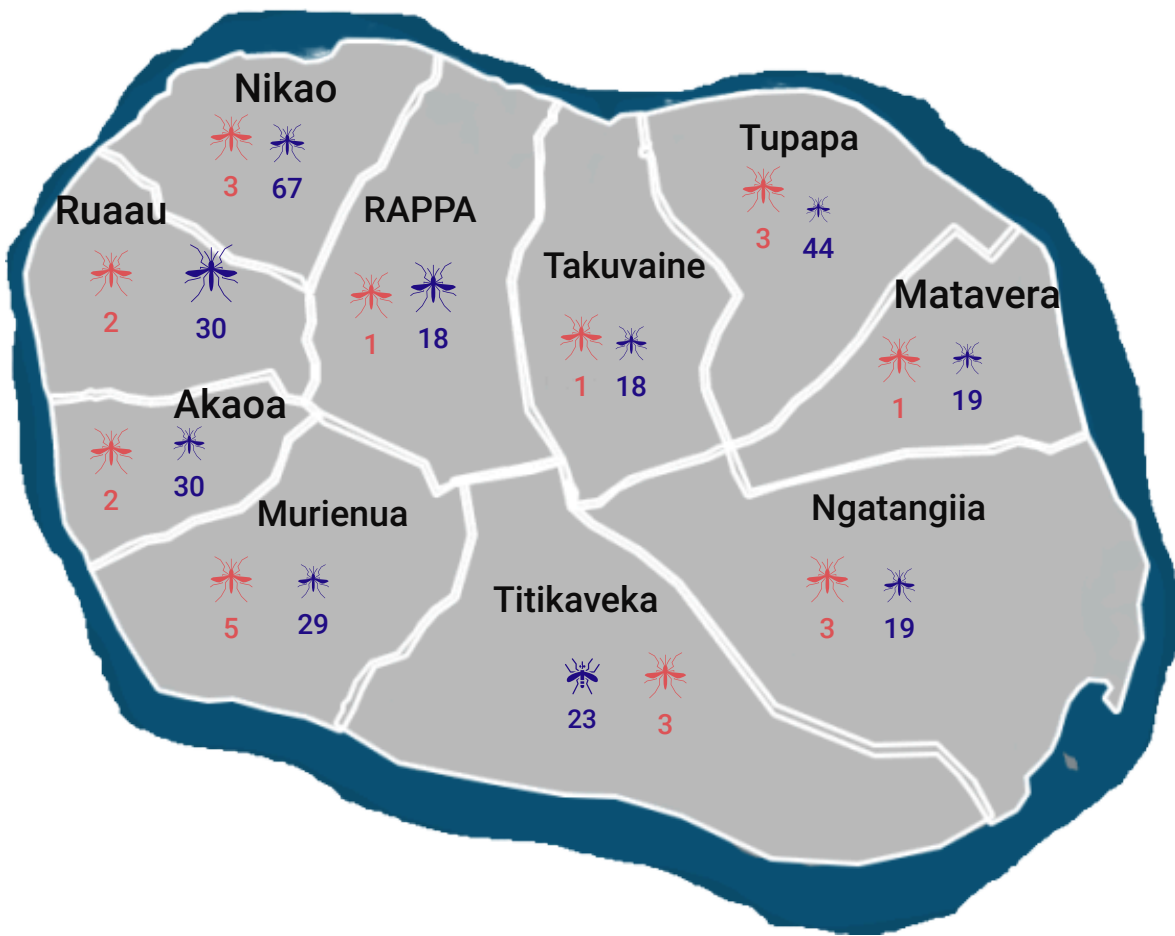

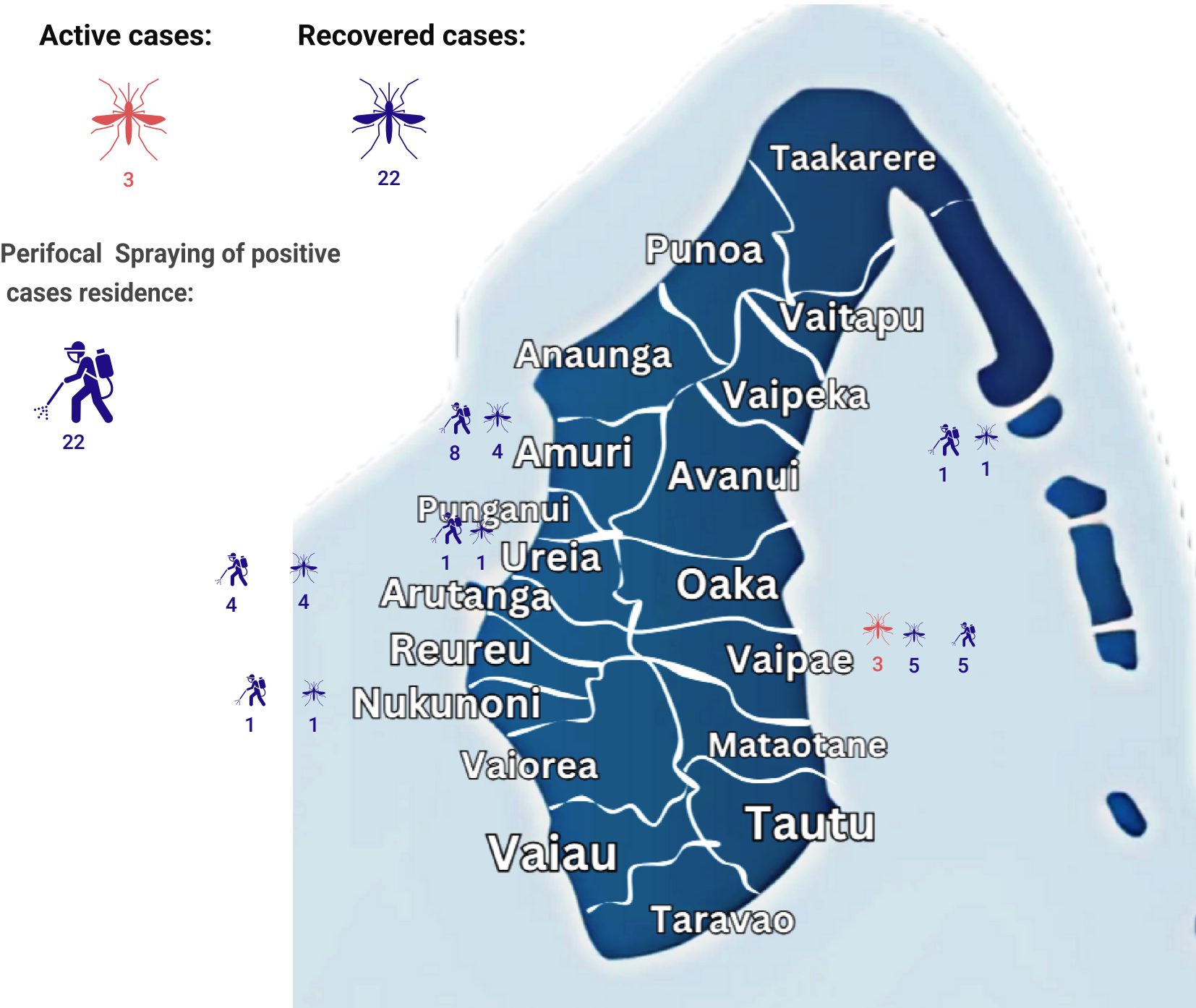
