Vector Control Programme

- Rarotonga: Peri-focal and block spraying targeting hot spots
- Risk assessments, and clean up: all islands.



Key Messages

- Destroy all mosquito breeding and resting sites
- Seek medical attention if unwell



Community Action

- Community Awareness - emptying water containers, use of repellent.
- Safe use of mosquito coils, and indoor use of mortein fly spray



Border Control (Domestic flights)

- Border measures will be implemented as required



Dengue Cases by Epidemiological Week, Cook Islands (2025 - 2026)




NOTES:






